### Starting School September 2019

If you have a child born between **1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015** you must apply online at [www.telford.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.telford.gov.uk/admissions).

**Even if your child is in our nursery you must apply online by 15th January 2019.**

If you have any questions or do not have access to the internet please talk to Nursery staff who will be able to help you.

**Parents of children in Year 2 will need to apply for Year 3 (Junior School) using the same online system.**

To help keep pupils and parents safe on the school site we request that you do not drive onto the school site at the start or end of the day or nursery session. Please do not park in the Children's Centre car park.



Parking is for permit holders only. Disabled parking spaces are available in the car park by the Nursery entrance and the Children's Centre car park. If you need to use one of these spaces please talk to the school office to request a permit and make sure you also display a valid blue badge. Blue badges should only be used if the person it belongs to is getting out of the car to collect a child.

We have received advice about action we can take if parents persist in driving on to school grounds without a permit. This can involve banning a parent from the school site or the police taking action.
