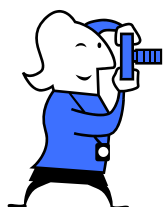

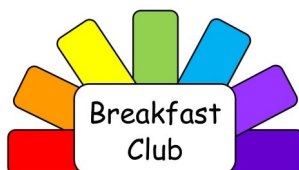
Reading at Home
