

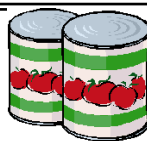


Donnington Wood Infant School & Nursery

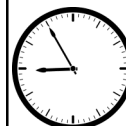

Parents of children in Year 2 will need to apply for Year 3 (Junior School) using the same online system.
