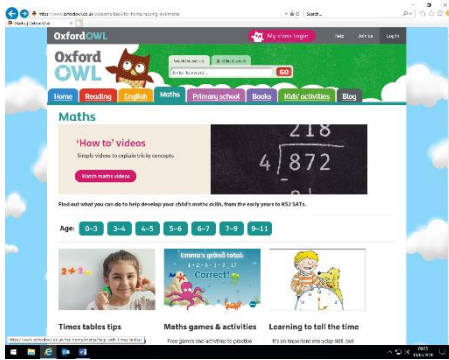


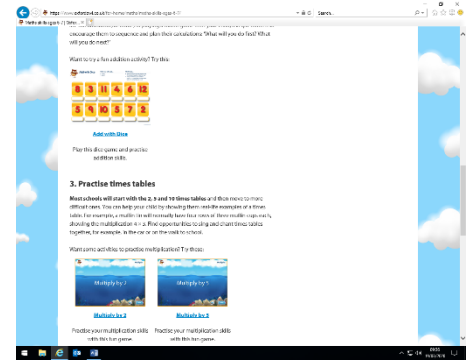

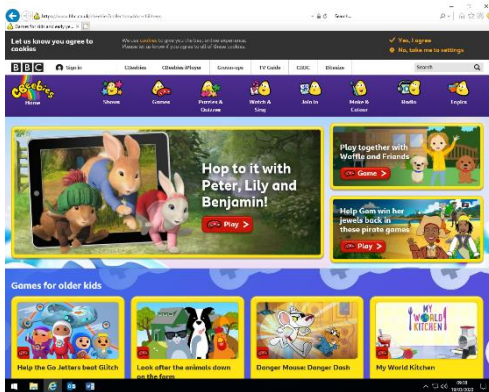

Oxford Owl has lots of maths activities for different age groups and are offering free access to all children. Click on your children's age group for a selection of activities.

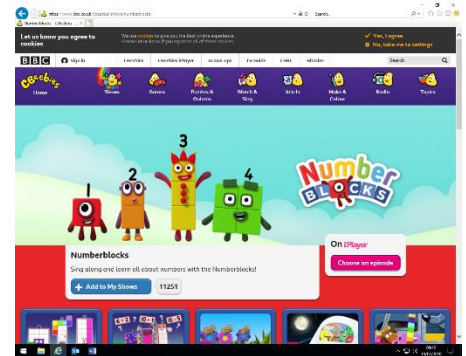

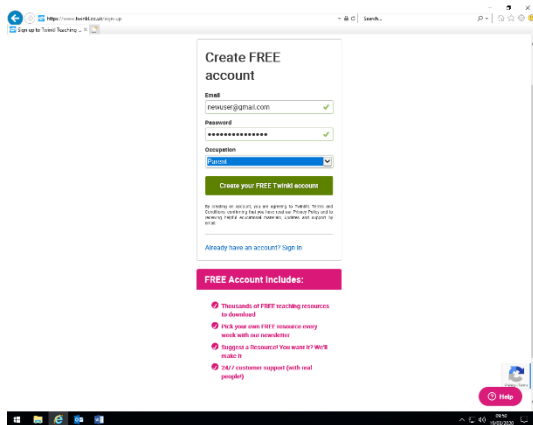


Twinkl

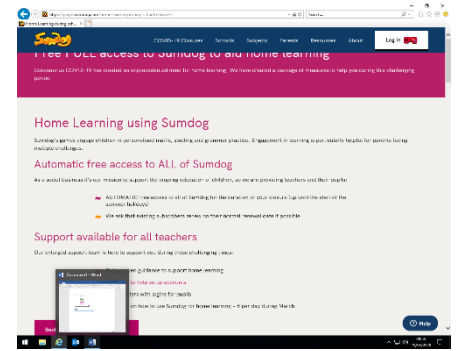
