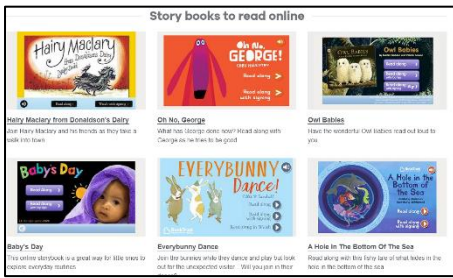


## Reading and Phonics

**CBeebies** has lots of stories for children to listen to at

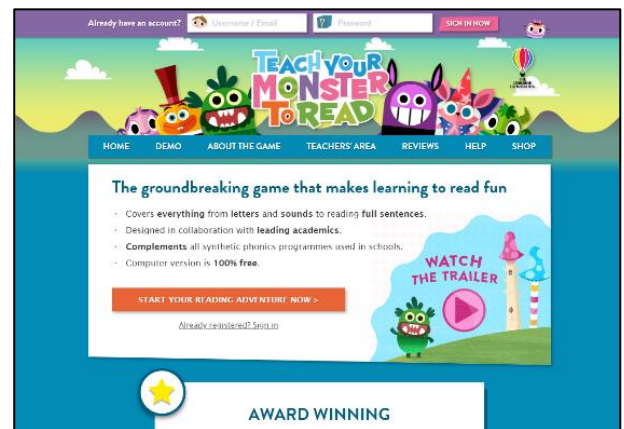

**Phonics Play** has many phonics and reading games. We use it in school so children may already be familiar with the activities. Now you can log in free with the

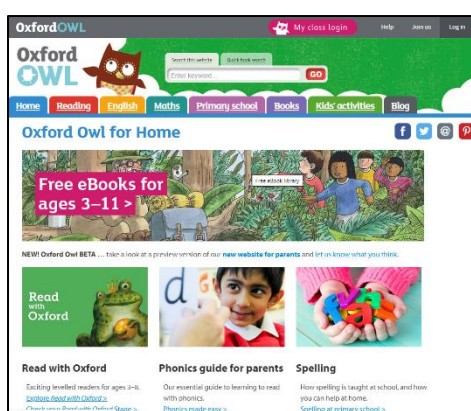
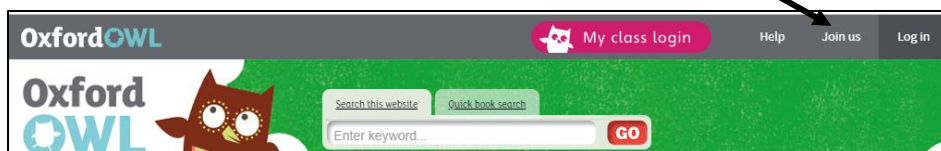
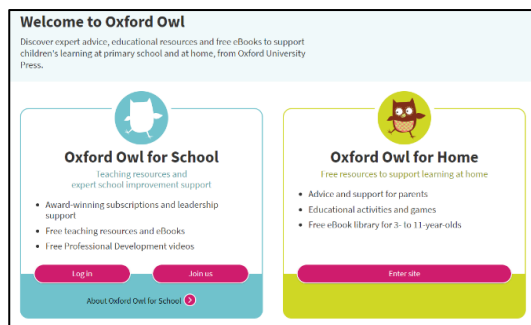

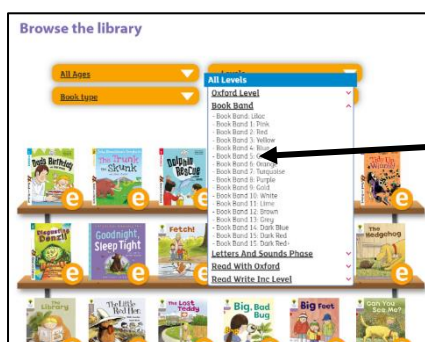
**Oxford Owl** is a good website to access e-books, phonics, reading and maths activities. There is also lots of advice on this website regarding how to support your child's learning at home.

In order to access resources you will need to **register** with them. Just click on the 'Join us' button at the top of the page. It is **free**.



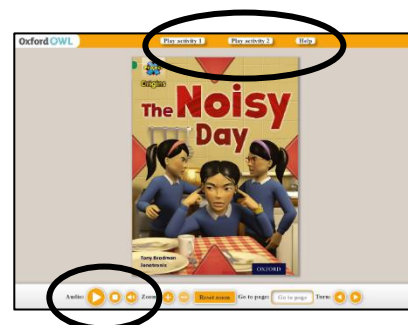
When you enter the 'Oxford Owl for Home' this page comes up. On the 'Free e-book library', you can select books that match the coloured banded books that your child brings home each day. You will need to log in to access most books.



Select 'Levels'

You can then choose the book band according to your child's reading level.

Many of the books have an audio feature, so that your child can listen to the story whilst also reading it themselves. Most of the e-books within this section of the website also have comprehension activities that your child can complete after reading the book.



**Espresso** (which can be accessed through 'Links' on our website, username: **student26905** and password: **school**) has lots of phonics and reading activities. There are stories to listen to and activities to complete, such as sequencing a story, comprehension questions and quizzes.
