## Easter themed activities

Ideas for things to do at home with your child.

*Choose a couple of activities you would like to do at home with your child each day.*

Make some chocolate nests with cereal. Decorate them with chocolate eggs. Send a photo to school.	Draw some Easter objects and colour them in. You could draw Easter bunnies, Easter eggs, lambs or flowers.	Make your own Easter egg trail. Draw some Easter eggs on some paper. Next, draw arrows on paper and put them around the house. Lead your family to your Easter picture!	We spell Easter like this:  E a s t e r  Can you think of something else that begins with each letter?	Use water and a paintbrush. Make some egg shapes on the ground outside. You could try and draw a fluffy lamb too!
Use your school login and type "Easter" in the search bar on <b>purple mash</b> . There are lots of fun things to do on there.	Help your grown up to cook some eggs for breakfast, lunch or tea. Have them fried, scrambled or dipped!	If there are 10 eggs in a basket and 5 get eaten. How many would be left in the basket? You could use your fingers or draw a picture to help you.	Play tag in the garden. The person who is 'it' is "the fox".  Can they catch "the rabbits"?	Make some Easter egg repeating patterns. Draw, paint or print egg shapes in a coloured pattern.
Draw around or paint your hand. Turn it into an Easter bunny picture.	Get some pots, pans and wooden spoons out. Can you make your own Easter band? You could make Easter animal masks and perform it to your family.	Make some Easter biscuits. Decorate them with some icing. Eat and enjoy! Draw some egg shapes on paper. Use some scissors and carefully cut them out. Try and stay on the lines.	Imagine you are going shopping to buy some Easter treats. Write a shopping list of all things you need.	Sing and dance to the "sleeping bunnies" song. Look it up on YouTube if your grown-ups don't know it!	Use your school login and type "Easter" in the search bar on <b>Espresso</b> . There are lots of fun things to do on there.	Share a story together. Have you got any stories about chicks, lambs or bunnies?
