# Choose 4 activities you would like to do at home with your child each day.

#### Year 1- Harry and His Bucketful of Dinosaurs

Make a trumpet by rolling a piece of paper or card into a cone — stick it with some tape.  2. Make a didgeridoo. Use a card tube — paint it and make it look like a dinosaur (add scales and eyes and a mouth)  3. Make a castanet by folding a piece of card in half and gluing a button or bottle lid to each side (leave to dry before testing it)
