




Year 2- The Rainbow Fish

Read The Rainbow Fish (All this week's activities are loosely based around it) https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IEOvkGgM8k	Rainbow fish shared his scales with his friends. Find some coins and see if you can share it out into equal piles. How much do you have each?	Phonics –How many words can you think of that use the alternative “ow” sound like in “rainbow”?	Challenge yourself to write a list of all the creatures you might find in the ocean.	How many adjectives can you think of to describe different sea creatures. Make it into an acrostic poem. S harp pointed teeth H appy grin to lure you in A ngry snap of the jaws R eally dark eyes K iller personality
Chocolate can be rainbow colours like the rainbow fish. Grab some smarties, M&Ms or skittles. Sort out the different colours and then show your results in a graph.	Make some masks for the story and act it out with your family.	Use some coloured paper and have a go at weaving your own rainbow fish. 	Research different underwater habitats that the different sea creatures live in. Find out what they eat, their name and which ocean they are found in.	
Invent another “rainbow” animal such as a rainbow bird or a rainbow butterfly. Write a story about them. What might happen to them?	Rainbow fish had shiny scales. How many shiny objects can you find in your house? Can you find out why they are shiny?		Solve this maths challenge. Seaweed Snacks Rainbow Fish and his friends love a seaweed snack. He has 10 snacks in his cave. Some are green and tasty, but some are bad and rotten. How many combinations of good and bad seaweed snacks could he have? 	
Create a shoebox under the ocean scene. Make your own sea creatures and use string to dangle them down into your underwater scene.	Can you make a fish picture using 2D shapes? When you have finished write down the shapes that you used.	Write a book review of the story. Include a brief summary, who the characters were, what you liked and disliked about the story. Don't forget to give it a rating out of 5 stars too!	Learn the names of the 5 oceans and the 7 continents. This song might help you remember: https://www.singup.org/singupathome/the-geography-song	This story is about friendship. Write down what it means to be a good friend.
How many other words can you make out of the words: The Rainbow Fish.	Practise saying your number bonds to 20 really fast. Cut these shells up and then try and match them up. https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-t-5552-shell-number-bonds-0-20	Make your own comic strip based on the rainbow fish. Give the characters speech bubbles and think about what they said in the story.	Phonics - How do we make a word plural? The word “fish” changes to “fishes” when there is more than one. How many other words can you find that end “es” when they are plural?	Create a rainbow fish collage.
