Dear Parents

Welcome back to school and nursery! It was really fantastic to see everyone today in school and nursery. The children have been absolutely brilliant and really enjoyed seeing their friends again. We have lots of new children joining school and nursery and we look forward to getting to know them over the next few weeks.

We are really excited about the term ahead and getting going with all the exciting learning we have prepared for everyone. Attendance today is really high and we hope this will continue over coming weeks.

Thank you so much for your patience and understanding this morning as we all get used to new routines. In order to keep everyone as safe as possible we have made a few changes to arriving and leaving school and nursery. Members of staff will be on duty to ensure everything runs smoothly and we expect parents to remain respectful towards staff at all times.

Please remember the following when dropping off or collecting from school and nursery -



Parents in Classes 1,2,3,&4 are not allowed down the ramps towards the classrooms. If you have a message to pass to your child's teacher then please tell a member of staff who is on duty on the playground (wearing a hi-vis jacket)
Please only go to your child's drop-off place. Please do not go to other areas with friends / other families. This is to keep everyone as safe as possible.
Parents must keep a 2m distance between themselves, others parents and staff at all times.

Please do not drive onto the school site at the start or end of the day or nursery session. Please do not park in the Children's Centre car park. If you have a blue disabled badge then please contact the school office to discuss parking.

If you drive to school then please park considerately. We received complaints this morning about cars being parked and blocking driveways.



Thank you to everyone who sent their child with a named water bottle today. **Children should only have water (not juice or squash) in their water bottles**. Bottles will come home each day and to be washed ready for the next day.

<u>Illness</u>

We know that some parents are concerned about illness and lots of false information is circulating on the internet.

- If any child (or member of staff) is unwell we will follow our usual procedure of contacting parents immediately so that you can collect your child.
- If your child is showing any COVID-19 symptoms in school / nursery we will provide you with the most recent government guidance including testing and they will need to remain at home for 10 days.
- If your child (or anyone in your house) is unwell with COVID-19 symptoms then please do not come to school or nursery.
- Please notify the office if your child is absent. You must give us the reason for their absence as we are currently required to report certain symptoms.

In order to minimise the number of things moving between school / nursery and home we would like to move to sending all letters and newsletters home using email. This letter will be emailed to the first named contact on our records.

- If you receive this letter by email today then you do not need to do anything.
- If you do not receive the email then please email <u>donnwood.infants@taw.org.uk</u> giving your child's name and we will update our records.
- If you do not have an email address then please let us know so that we can make sure you still have access to letters.
