GETTING A COVID-19 TEST

in Telford and Wrekin

You MUST get a test if:

You have at least **one** of the three main symptoms.



High temperature



New persistent cough



Loss of taste or smell

ISOLATE as soon as symptoms show, while waiting for test results and if you test positive.

You **CAN** get a test for these precautionary symptoms:



Headaches



Aches and pains



Feeling very tired for no good reason



Sore throat



Runny nose



Sneezing



Tummy ache in children

You **DO NOT NEED TO ISOLATE** if you have **only one or more of these precautionary symptoms**, or while waiting for test results for these precautionary symptoms.

You only need to isolate if you test positive or have at least one of the three main symptoms.

Book a test at nhs.uk/coronavirus

For **precautionary symptoms testing** select: 'My local council or health protection team has asked me (or someone I live with) to get a test, even though I do not have symptoms'.

Please make sure you contact the office (386640 or donnwood.infants@taw.org.uk) if your child is absent from school and nursery. It is vital that we know why children are absent so that we can keep everyone safe. Thank you.
