Starting School September 2021

If you have a child born between

1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017

you must apply online at www.telford.gov.uk/ admissions

There are no paper application forms.

Even if your child is in our nursery you *must apply online* by 15th January 2021

If you have any questions or do not have access to the internet please talk to the office.

Parents of children in Year 2 will need to apply for Year 3 (Junior School) using the same online system.

In the cooler weather it is really important that your child comes to school or nursery wearing a jumper / cardigan and has a suitable coat. Although the heating is on, we are currently also required to keep windows



open so there is good ventilation in rooms.

GETTING A COVID-19 TEST

in Telford and Wrekin

You MUST get a test if:

You have at least one of the three main symptoms.



temperature



persistent cough



of taste or smell

ISOLATE as soon as symptoms show, while waiting for test results and if you test positive.

You **CAN** get a test for these precautionary symptoms:



Headaches



Aches and pains



Feeling very tired for no good reason



Sore throat



Runny nose



Sneezing

You DO NOT NEED TO ISOLATE if you have only one or more of these precautionary symptoms, or while waiting for test results for these precautionary symptoms.

You only need to isolate if you test positive or have at least one of the three main symptoms.

For precautionary symptoms testing select:

'My local council or health protection team has asked me (or someone I live with) to get a test, even though I do not have symptoms'.
