Testing

Adults in households with primary school, secondary school and college age children, including childcare and support bubbles, are advised to test themselves twice every week at home. The twice-weekly test kits in Telford & Wrekin (for people feeling well, with no coronavirus symptoms) can be accessed 1:30-7pm from any testing site (the nearest is Donnington Wood Bowling Club, School Road, Donnington, Telford, TF2 8HU.



Anyone with main or precautionary coronavirus symptoms is advised to book a test immediately at one of the borough's NHS 'Test and trace' sites.

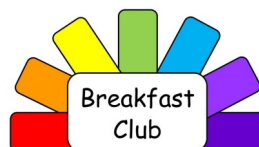
Reading at home

This week children in school have started to bring home reading books. We have also sent out information about how to support your children with reading at home during the week. Reading at home is really important to give children as many opportunities as possible to become fluent and confident readers.

Please write in your child's Reading Record every time they read so they can collect prizes in school. Reading Records will be checked every Monday. Every 10 reads your child can collect a small prize. Every 50 reads and they can choose a book to take home and keep.

The system will be the same as last term with **new books coming home on Monday** and being **returned to school on Friday**. This system allows us to keep everyone as safe as possible.

Your child does not need to bring their reading book to school every day, we have other books in school for children to read during the week.

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Water Bottles

Please make sure your child has a water bottle in school everyday. If your child has a different drink for lunchtime then please put this in their lunch box. Water is available for all children in the hall at lunchtime.



Parking

To help keep pupils and parents safe on the school site we request that you do not drive onto the school site at the start or end of the day or nursery session. Please do not park in the Children's Centre car park.

Disabled parking spaces are available in the car park by the Nursery entrance and the Children's Centre car park. If you need to use one of these spaces please talk to the school office to request a permit and make sure you also display a valid blue badge. The spaces may only be used if the blue badge holder is the child coming to nursery / school or the adult blue badge holder is getting out of the car to bring a child in to nursery or school.

GETTING A COVID-19 TEST in Telford and Wrekin



You MUST get a test if:

You have at least **one** of the three main symptoms.



High temperature



New persistent cough



Loss of taste or smell

ISOLATE as soon as symptoms show, while waiting for test results and if you test positive.

You **CAN** get a test for these precautionary symptoms:



Headaches



Aches and pains



Feeling very tired for no good reason



Sore throat



Runny nose



Sneezing



Tummy ache in children

You **DO NOT NEED TO ISOLATE** if you have **only one or more of these precautionary symptoms**, or while waiting for test results for these precautionary symptoms.

You only need to isolate if you test positive or have at least one of the three main symptoms.

For precautionary symptoms testing select:

'My local council or health protection team has asked me (or someone I live with) to get a test, even though I do not have symptoms.'
