It is hard to believe that we finish for the Easter holidays next Thursday. It has been such an unusual term but working together it has been successful and we are really proud of our whole school community.





Testing

Adults in households with primary school, secondary school and college

age children, including childcare and support bubbles, are advised to test themselves twice every week at home. The twice-weekly test kits in Telford & Wrekin (for people feeling well, with no coronavirus symptoms) can be accessed 1:30-7pm from any testing site (the nearest is Donnington Wood Bowling Club, School Road, Donnington, Telford, TF2 8HU.

Anyone with main or precautionary coronavirus symptoms is advised to book a test immediately at one of the borough's NHS 'Test and trace' sites.

Parking To help keep pupils and parents safe

GETTING A COVID-19 TEST



in Telford and Wrekin

You MUST get a test if:

You have at least one of the three main symptoms.





High temperature

persistent cough

of taste or

ISOLATE as soon as symptoms show, while waiting for test results and if you test positive.

You **CAN** get a test for these precautionary symptoms:









Aches and pains

Feeling very tired for no good reason







You DO NOT NEED TO ISOLATE if you have only one or more of these precautionary symptoms, or while waiting for test results for these precautionary symptoms.

You only need to isolate if you test positive or have at least one of the three main symptoms.

For precautionary symptoms testing select:

'My local council or health protection team has asked me (or someone I live with) to get a test, even though I do not have symptoms'.
