Starting school?

Closing date for applications: **15 January 2022**

www.telford.gov.uk/admissions

- You must apply if your child was born between 1 September 2017 31 August 2018.
- You must apply even if your child is attending a nursery or pre-school on a school site or you have a child already attending the school.
- Attending a nursery does not guarantee a school place.
- If a child has an Education, Health & Care Plan the closing date is 31 October 2021 for all applications.
- School places are allocated in line with oversubscription criteria.

Starting School September 2022

Even if your child is in our nursery you *must apply online by 15th* January 2022

There are no paper application forms.

If you have any questions or do not have access to the internet please talk to the office.

Parents of children in Year 2 will need to apply for Year 3 (Junior School) using the same online system.

Illness & Testing

If your child is unwell with COVID symptoms (high temperature, or new continuous dry cough or loss of taste / smell) then please do not send them to school and arrange for a PCR (test centre) test as soon as possible. If your child is unwell for any other reason then they can continue to attend school (if they are well enough) but we are still advising a PCR (test centre) test as symptoms in children can vary.

If your child has a PCR test then please let us know the outcome as soon as possible (by phone 386640 or email donnwood.infants@taw.org.uk) so that we know if we need to take any additional action in school or nursery. Thank you to all the parents who have kept us up to date this week with tests and results.

The number of cases in Telford is still very high. We really encourage all adults to carry out regular lateral flow tests even if you are feeling well. Staff in school carry out lateral flow tests regularly.

Anyone with main coronavirus symptoms is advised to book a test immediately at one of the borough's NHS testing sites or attend the walk-in test

If you are not signed up please let us know so we can sort it as soon as possible. You can let the office know or a member of staff on duty before or after school. It is free to use and parents who are already using it really love seeing what their child has been doing.

Thank you to everyone who is sending their child with a named water bottle. **Children** should only have water (not juice,

squash, pop or fizzy drinks) in their water bottles in the classroom. This is to comply with the School Food Standards. Bottles will come home each day to be washed .
