Parking

To help keep pupils and parents safe on the school site we request that you do not drive onto the school site at the start or end of the day or nursery session.

Please do not park in the Children's Centre car park.

Disabled parking spaces are available in the car park by the Nursery entrance and the Children's Centre car park. If you need to use one of these spaces please talk to the school office to request a permit and make sure you also display a valid blue badge.

The yellow zig-zag markings at all 3 entrances are designed to keep everyone safe. Please do not park on the yellow zigzags.

Water Bottles

Children no longer need to bring water bottles to school to use in class. We are providing individual, named cups, which are washed daily, for all children.

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If your child has a drink for lunchtime then please send this in a named bottle. Please do not send fizzy drinks or pop for lunchtime. Water is available for all children in the hall at lunchtime.
