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



Even if your child is in our nursery you *must apply online by* 15th January 2024

Parents of Year 2 children need to apply for Junior School using the same online system.

Now that start of year assessments have been completed, children in school are bringing books home to read. We know that regular reading to an adult can support children to make fantastic progress with learning to read, and becoming fluent readers. Please encourage your child to read regularly at home so they can collect their prizes in school. We expect children to
