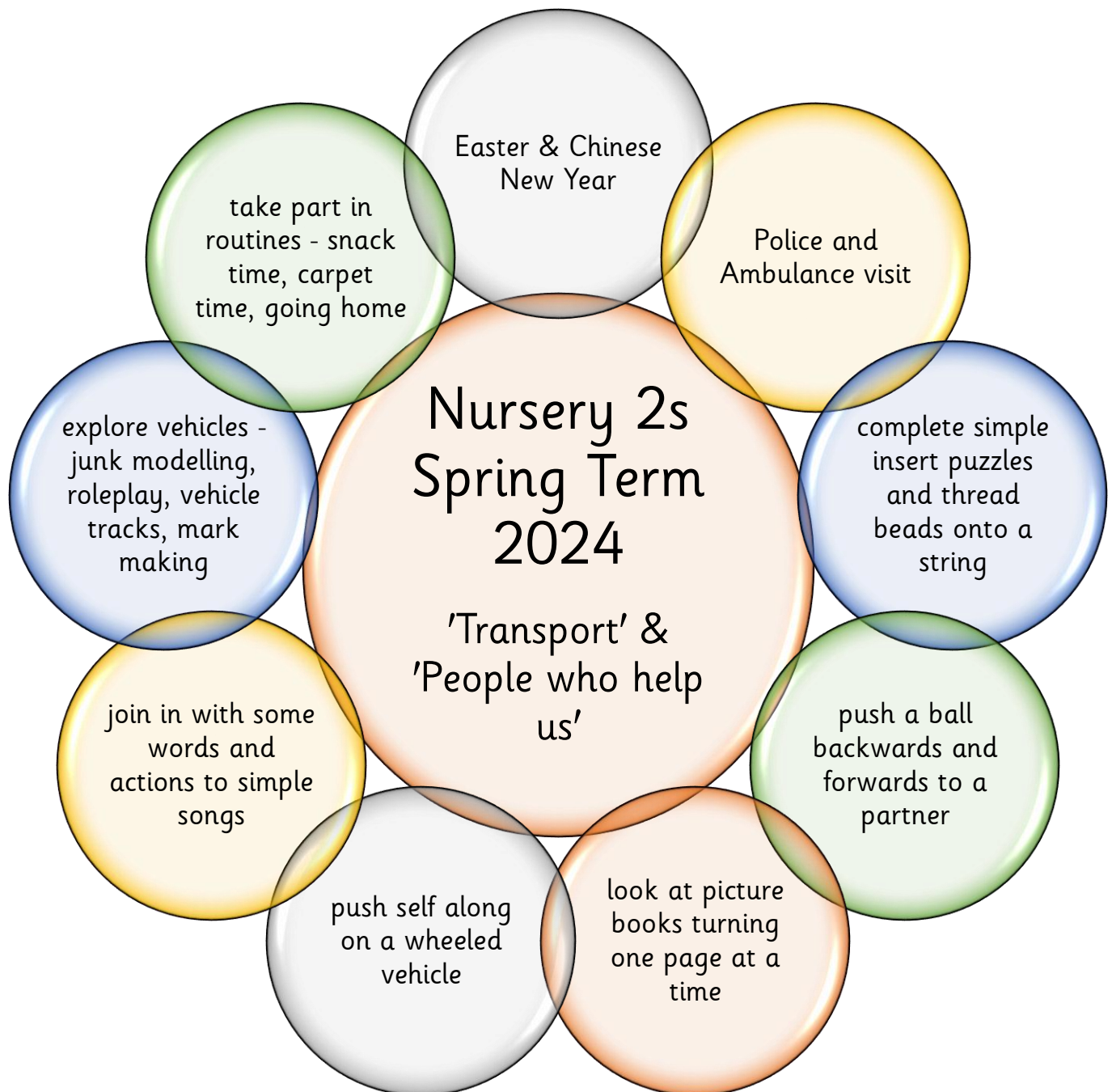


Donnington Wood Infant School and Nursery

Transport & People who help us



Listening, Attention and understanding

Understand simple questions and instructions (Go and get your coat. Where's baby?)
Know names of everyday objects
Follow along with words to a song
Be able to sit still and listen to a short story
Know different areas in Nursery – snack, carpet, outside
Know where to find own belongings – coat peg

Speaking

Know names of everyday objects
Follow along with words to a song
Knows how to put 2 or 3 words together to make a sentence
Knows some basic words to describe something that happened in the past such as "I did that"
Know the names of adults who look after them in Nursery
Knows when we ask a question, we get an answer

Building relationships

Know the names of adults who look after them in Nursery
Seeing emergency services in a safe environment
Exploring new experiences from different cultures e.g. new foods, dancing

Self Regulation

Know where to find own belongings – coat peg

Self Management

Knows ways to calm themselves
Know what is right and what is wrong

Gross motor

Knows how to push feet to move a sit on vehicle
Knows how to sit on a nursery chair
Knows that some things are not safe to climb e.g. furniture inside Nursery
Knows you can move a ball using different part of the body e.g. pushing with hands

Fine motor

Knows how to hold a string between thumb and finger to thread
Knows how to use fingers to turn individual pages in a book
Knows that when building a tower, you need to place each piece steadily
Know that mark making tools leave marks and recognise the marks they have made
To know they can use their hands as a tool to change materials
