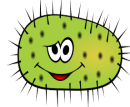

Parking

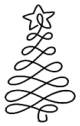

Donnington Wood Infant School & Nursery Christmas Activities

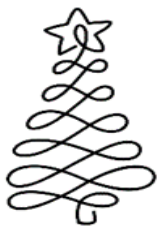
