

# Nursery 2s Summer Term



## In the garden and On the farm

#### Listening, Attention and understanding

Know the key events of some familiar events at home eg making tea, putting baby to bed

#### **Speaking**

Knows how to put 4 or 5 words together to make short sentences, such as "me want more juice", "him want his coat"

#### **Building** relationships

Recognise adults in 3s Nursery as a familiar adult

#### Self Regulation

Know where to find favourite toys in Nursery

Know where some familiar toys belong (help to tidy up)

Begin to follow some simple rules

Can read an adults facial expression and understands if they are sad or happy

Know Makaton signs for happy or sad

Recognise adults in 3s Nursery as a familiar adult

#### Self Management

Knows how to express a range of emotions.

Knows the things they can do for themselves and expresses this to others.

Follows some simple rules

Knows that we must wash hands with some adult support.

Knows how to take off own coat, shoes and socks with adult support

#### Gross motor

Know that we can move to music

Know some actions to familiar songs

Knows how to steer a sit on vehicle

Know that we can balance using our bodies in different ways e.g. standing on one foot

Know that some surfaces are 'wobbly' and we need to take care/ hold hands

#### Fine motor

Knows how to use thumb and finger to pick up small pieces/objects

Knows that pieces in an insert puzzle will only fit in the correct shape

Know that if you tip a container the contents can be moved

Know how to press or pull buttons
