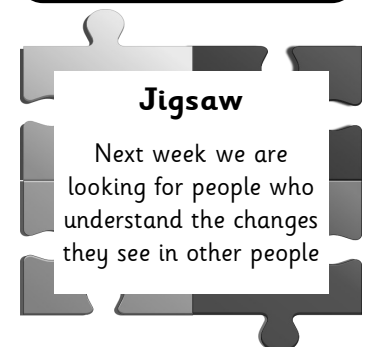

Water Bottles
