Breakfast



An increasing number of children are arriving at school telling staff that they have not eaten breakfast before coming to school. We realise that sometimes this is because children have refused to eat what an adult has given them at home. We would really encourage children to be eating a healthy breakfast at home (cereal, porridge, toast etc) before coming to school. Children in school are offered toast / bagel when they arrive, but this is a healthy snack and is not a replacement for breakfast.

Even if your child is in our nursery you must still apply online by 15th January 2025

Parents of Year 2 children need to apply for Junior School using the same online system.
