More After School clubs	<p>We have aimed to offer as many clubs as possible and they remained very popular with more children requesting places than we could offer. Clubs are run by staff on a voluntary basis to keep costs for parents as low as possible.</p> <p><i>2024-25 - We are exploring having of a 5-day-a-week After School Club. We will update you as we make progress with this.</i></p>
More learning for children and parents about additional needs	<p>We are really excited to be taking part in a Neurodiversity Project (PINS) during 2024-25. This will help develop pupil, staff and parent knowledge of additional needs and support available.</p>
ParentPay (or similar)	<p>We are now taking payment for 30 hours nursery children via bank transfer.</p> <p><i>2024-25 - We will look to see if this can be expanded to Breakfast Club. We will also look again at Parent Pay and similar providers to see if</i></p>
Healthier food	<p>Our current school menu meets the School Food Standards.</p> <p><i>2024-25 – We will offer parents the opportunity to comment and feedback about the menu when it is revised for Easter 2025.</i></p>
